CALL FOR PROPOSALS Hans und Lotte Hass Marine Conservation Award



The Haus des Meeres promotes a marine conservation project with reference to Austria.

Possible contents are the **protection of marine habitats or organisms** through **research projects** or through **applied conservation projects** on site or also through **campaigns which publicise topics relevant to marine protection**.

A maximum of € 6.000 will be awarded for this purpose to enable the project to be carried out through travel and material costs or contracts for work with third parties (contracts up to a maximum of 50% of the project sum).

The application must include:

- ✓ the title of the submitted conservation project
- ✓ a description in English, with a cost plan (max. four A4 pages long)
- ✓ the names of the institutions involved in the project
- ✓ information on any other funding applied for or already approved.
- ✓ a curriculum vitae of the submitting person(s)
